Biblical Justice

Care for the poor, vulnerable, and marginalized (Proverbs 3:27; Isaiah 1:17; Zechariah 7:10; and Micah 6:8)

Equal treatment and advocacy for the poor, vulnerable, and marginalized (Proverbs 31:8-9, 20:10, 17:23, 18:5)

Reflects God's character for the poor, vulnerable, and marginalized (Proverbs 1:3, 17:5; Deuteronomy 10:17-18)

Includes generosity for the poor, vulnerable, and marginalized (Proverbs 14:21, 31, 19:17, 28:27)

Living with redemptive value

The gospel is our driving motive and message (Proverbs 22:2; Micah 6:8; Exodus 22:21-23; Matthew 6:25-33)

Justice is our responsibility, not out of obligation but opportunity (Romans 15:26-27; Luke 14:12-14; Matthew 23:23, 25:34-40; James 1:27, 2:1-26)

Generosity is an act of joy and it honors the Lord (Romans 15:26-27; 2 Corinthians 8-9; Proverbs 14:31)
